#### Typical applications:

Light and medium duty carton sealing tape. Suitable either with a manual dispenser or automated application.

### Advantages and benefits:

ISCC PLUS certified adhesive tape with 50% recycled film\* supporting the transition to a circular economy.

Traceability to the origin of the recycled material for the backing: BIO-CIRCULAR FILM\*.

At the end of the product's lifetime, it can be deposited into the plastic recycling container to be **completely recycled** using mechanical or chemical recycling.

Excellent adhesion to all surfaces.

Light film developed for sustainable packaging.

## **Construction:**

Backing: 50% recycled\* certified polypropylene certified by ISCC PLUS.

The cardboard core is made from 100% recycled material.

Adhesive: **Natural rubber**. Colour: Clear, white or brown.
